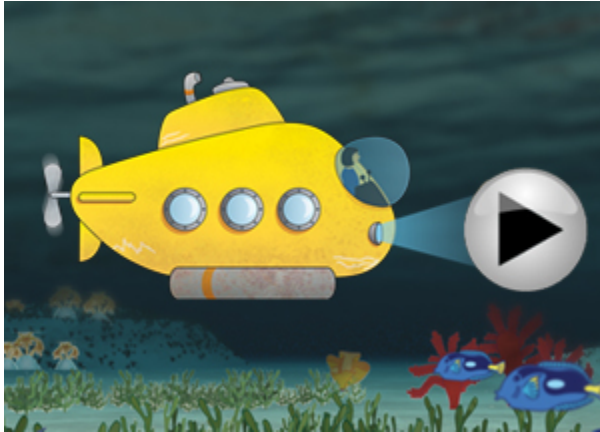

▶ NEW POLICY FOR GLOBAL CAMPUS PROCTORING SERVICES

Global Campus Proctoring Services has implemented a new policy beginning spring semester 2017 for all exams sent to on-site proctors:

Exams that are requested more than 10 business days in advance will be sent to the proctor by U.S. mail, unless otherwise requested, and no fee will be charged for the delivery of the exam.

Exams that are requested within 10 business days of the scheduled exam date will incur a \$15.00 rush delivery fee. The exam will be sent to the student's on-site proctor by email, and the rush fee will be billed to the student's account.

Deadline to pay [tuition and fees](#) without a 5 percent late fee.
