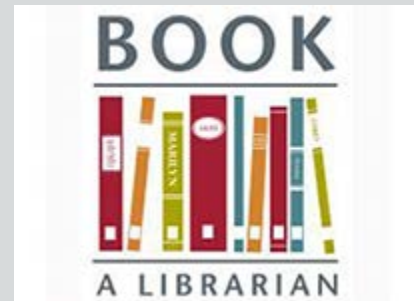


## COOKING WITH CHEF JAMIE
